### English

This half term children will be leading their writing.

They will be choosing to write for a variety of different purposes, for example: a list of ingredients to make a smoothie or a pancake, a book for World Book Day and a variety of posters.

We will also be continuing to learn our Bear Words and increase our knowledge in phonics.

### Maths

This half term we will be deepening our knowledge of number by looking at a number of the week in detail.
